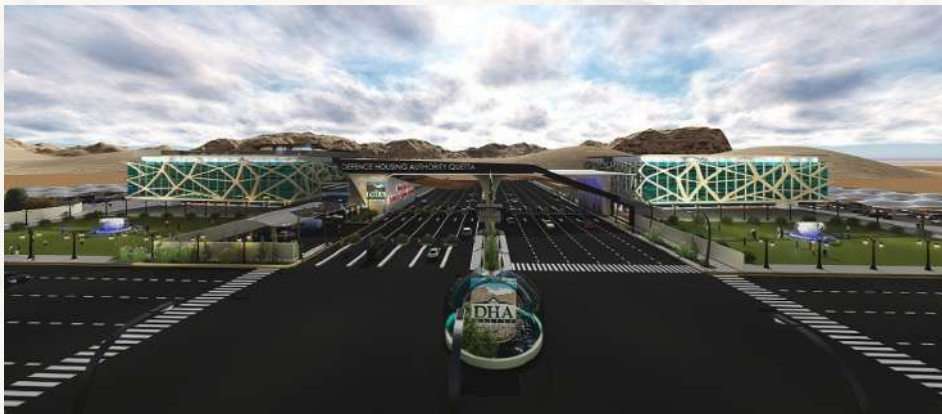

INTRODUCTION:

The Institute of Architects Pakistan Quetta Chapter (**IAP-QC**), in collaboration with the Defense Housing Authority (**DHA**) **Quetta**, is thrilled to announce a nationwide design competition for Architects and Architecture students throughout Pakistan.

Spearheaded by **IAP-QC**, this competition calls for groundbreaking Design Proposals for Theme Park, Monument, and Feature wall to be situated along the main **DHA Avenue**. The initiative aims to significantly enhance the aesthetic appeal, cultural richness, and recreational offerings of **DHA Quetta**, positioning **IAP-QC** as a key driver in the development and beautification of this prominent area.



CATEGORIES:

1. Theme Park

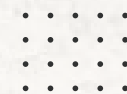
Designs should incorporate Recreational areas, Landscaping, Playgrounds, and Community spaces. Emphasis on sustainability, local culture, and innovative use of space (Site dimensions and North reference and can be seen in Masterplan).

2. Monument

Proposals for Monument that reflect the heritage, history, and aspirations of the people of Quetta. Creative integration of Art, Architecture, and Symbolism (Design should not exceed than 12'x12' site area and height must be not more than 25').

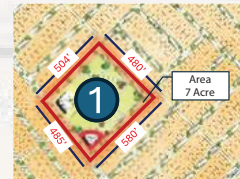
3. Feature Wall

Design of Artistic feature wall that add visual interest and identity to the main **DHA Avenue**. Use of materials and designs that withstand local climatic conditions and urban environment. (Length 60' and height 12')

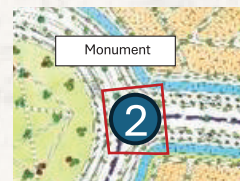




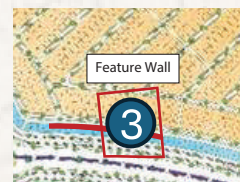

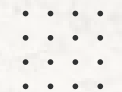


JUDGING CRITERIA

- Sustainability

- Functionality And User Experience
- Cost And Feasibility (in general perspective)
- Integration With The Environment

KEY DESIGN CONSIDERATIONS

1. Participants are encouraged to use innovative materials and techniques.
2. Designs should be cost-effective, easy to maintain, and suitable for local climatic conditions.
3. Incorporate features that enhance community interaction and accessibility.
4. Proposals should include detailed descriptions of materials, construction methods, and cost estimates.



IMPORTANT NOTES:



- One design entry per category (Theme Parks, Monuments, Feature Walls) will be submitted by each participant.
- Submissions must be received by the Convenor Competition at the prescribed time, date, and address.
- Instructions given in the Competition Program must be strictly followed.
- The working language of the Awards and all correspondence concerning the Awards and all related explanatory texts, labels, captions, completion of Forms, etc., i.e., all written matter submitted by the entrants to the Awards, will be in English.
- Designs must be original work of the participant.
- Participants will be excluded from the competition if attempts to approach or influence the Jury Panel either individually and/ or collectively.
- All materials submitted shall become the property of IAPQC and DHA Quetta, and if desired by IAPQC / DHA Quetta, may be displayed or published at their discretion.
- All Design proposals must be submitted electronically only in PDF Format (Acrobat) in one file separate for each category quettachapter@iap.com.pk
- Entries are to be received by 1700 hours on 05/10/2024. Any entry received after this time will not be accepted.
- Entries will be judged anonymously by the jury

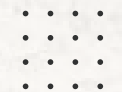

- The judging of entries will be carried out anonymously. In order to ensure this, neither the name nor any distinguishing marks, logo, indication may appear on any page.
- The entry shall bear the Identity Code issued by the Organizer upon receiving the registration form and fee.
- All decisions taken by the Jury, and all Awards conferred by the Jury, shall be considered final and not subjected to appeal.



DELIVERABLES:



Participant shall submit the following materials separately for each category including:

1. Project Design using a maximum of four (4) sheets of A1 size per category showing.
 - a) Title along with concept, schematic diagrams, Plans, Elevations, Sections, 3D images and any details if needed.
 - b) Identity Code and Design Category must be mentioned on the lower right side of all A1 sheets along with IAP reg. number
2. A write-up of 250-500 words on A-4 portrait paper using Calibri Font size of 11 mentioning.
 - a) Design criteria, methodology and assumptions.
 - b) Rendered views of the project and/or design elements and systems.
 - c) Design codes (if any), Construction system and materials specifications.
 - d) Typical details to highlight major design elements.
